Notice Regarding Public Comment

in concordance with Montana State Law and Board Policies: 1400 Board Meetings 1420 School Board Meeting Procedure 1420F Notice Regarding Public Comment 1441 Public Participation at Board Meetings

Montana law requires school districts and other public agencies to include on the agenda for public meetings an item allowing public comment on any *public matter not otherwise specifically listed on the agenda* that is within the jurisdiction of the agency. The Board Chairman will call individuals to speak in the order listed, and only those who indicated such interest, on the sheet provided. Under Montana law, the Board must comply with the legal requirement to protect any individual's right of privacy. A member of the public wishing to address the Board during this time will not be allowed to make comments about any student, staff member, or member of the general public during his/her designated time to speak. In addition, the Board will not hear comments on contested cases or other adjudicative proceedings. When addressing the Board, please do so from the lectern provided so your comments can be heard and recorded accurately. These requests are procedural and not intended to prevent additional participation from the public at the discretion of the Board Chairperson.

Depending on the number of persons who wish to address the Board, the Board Chairman may place reasonable time limits on comments, in order to maintain and ensure effective and efficient operations of the Board.

By law the District cannot deliberate, debate or take any action on any matter presented during Public Comment portion of the meeting, until such time as the matter is specifically noticed on the agenda, and the public has been allowed the opportunity to comment.
