A. Election Issue: Determine the validity of 3 Declarations of Intent for Trustee Candidates that failed to be turned in to the District Clerk as required by 20-3-305.

Facts to Consider: As of the close of business on March 29th, Karsen Drury, the Election Official, received two (2) Declaration of Intent & Oath of Candidacy for Trustee Candidates forms: Rick Cummings & John Rumney. These forms were completed in entirety and certified with the Cascade County Elections Office. The forms were returned to the District before the OPI mandated Election Deadline for Trustee Candidates to file. On the morning of March 30th, Karsen contacted the County Elections Office to notify them that only two people filed with the District. They replied that three (3) additional people filed for candidacy. One filed on March 8th, while the other two filed on March 29th. Karsen was not notified of the filings until she contacted the County. The Declaration of Intent & Oath of Candidacy for Trustee Candidates form states that the forms are to be returned to the Election Official, Karsen Drury. It is also stated on the school website where to return the forms. If Karsen had not personally contacted the County, she would not have known that these candidates filed at all and would have possibly canceled the election. Karsen spoke with Patty Boyle, Cascade County Superintendent of Schools, who said that the Elections Office had all 3 original forms in their possession and will be mailing them to the District. The Election is being run by the District, not the County. In summary, 3 forms were filed with the County, but not with the District, before the deadline to do so. Are these Declaration of Intent forms valid or null? If the Board should find these forms to be null and void, the 3 Candidates have the option to file as a Write-In Candidate by April 5, 2018 at 5:00 pm with the District Clerk. The form is available on the school website and must also be certified by the County before the deadline to file with the District Clerk. MTSBA referred the District to MCA 20-3-305 (attached below), ultimately determining the forms are null since they did not meet the statutory requirements. MTSBA and OPI's advice and determination differed.

Option 1: Accept the advice of OPI to include on the official Election Ballot the 3 candidates who failed to file their Declarations of Intent for Trustee Candidates with the District Clerk as required by MCA 20-3-305.

Option 2: Accept the advice of MTSBA to declare the 3 candidates who failed to file their Declarations of Intent for Trustee Candidates with the District Clerk as required by MCA 20-3-305 null and void.

Attachment A - OPI Advice:



These election forms are valid. The county should not have accepted the forms and should have directed the individuals to return the forms to the district, or should have accepted the forms and immediately notified the district. However, the candidates were not given the corrective information in a timely manner and the forms were accepted as properly filed. Given that, the candidates should be considered legitimate trustee candidates and placed on the district ballot.

Attachment B - MCA 20-3-305:

20-3-305. Candidate qualification, filing deadline, and withdrawal. (1) Except as provided in 20-3-338, any person who is qualified to vote in a district under the provisions of 20-20-301 is eligible for the office of trustee.

(2) (a) Except as provided in subsection (2)(b), a declaration of intent to be a candidate must be submitted to the clerk of the district at least 40 days before the regular school election day at which the person is to be a candidate. If there are different terms to be filled, the term for the position for which the candidate is filing must also be indicated.

(b) A person seeking to become a write-in candidate for a trustee position shall file a declaration of intent no later than 5 p.m. on the day before the ballot certification deadline in 20-20-401.

(3) (a) A candidate intending to withdraw from the election shall send a statement of withdrawal to the clerk of the district. The statement must contain all information necessary to identify the candidate and the office for which the candidate filed. The statement of withdrawal must be acknowledged by the clerk of the district.

(b) A candidate may not withdraw after 5 p.m. the day before the ballot certification deadline in 20-20-401.

Attachment C - MCA 20-20-401:

20-3-305. Trustees' election duties -- ballot certification. (1) *The trustees are the general supervisors of school elections unless the trustees request and the county election administrator agrees to conduct a school election under 20-20-417.*


(2) Not less than 30 days before an election, the clerk of the district shall certify the ballot by preparing a certified list of the names of all candidates entitled to be on the ballot subject to 13-37-126 and certifying the official wording for each ballot issue. The candidates' names must appear on the ballot in accordance with 13-12-203. The clerk shall arrange for printing the ballots. Ballots for absentee voting must be printed and available at least 20 days before the election. Names of candidates on school election ballots need not be rotated.

(3) Before the opening of the polls, the trustees shall cause each polling place to be supplied with the ballots and supplies necessary to conduct the election.
