Decimals with Playing Cards

Materials:

Score Sheet (attached or you can draw your own)
Deck of regular playing cards (remove Face Cards)

Directions:

- 1. Shuffle the deck of cards and place them the deck of cards in a pile facedown.
- 2. Each player takes a turn taking one card from the top of the pile. Players place the card face-up in front of them so all other players can see each card that has been drawn.
- 3. Each player decides where to place their drawn number on the scoresheet. The player can only write that number once and cannot change it later after drawing more cards.
- 4. Players repeat the steps 2 & 3 until all 6 place value columns have been filled in (which means that 6 cards should have been drawn by each player).
- 5. Players show their final number to their opponents to determine who has written the highest number.
- 6. The player with the highest number wins that round.
- 7. Continue playing 10 round and whoever wins the most rounds is the winner!
