COVID HOME CONTEST PLAN Cascade Schools



All home contests will be broadcast on the NFHS network - nfhsnetwork.com

INDOOR CONTESTS

- Indoor contests are limited to 250 total people in attendance.
- Contact Tracing. Each team will provide a form with Student/Athlete guests. There will also be a sheet at the door for extra spectators.
- Home team athletes will be limited to four (4) spectators per athlete on the roster. The team members will be given four (4) tickets to hand out prior to each home game. Visiting teams will be limited to two (2) spectators per athlete on the roster.
- All spectators will enter through the commons door.
- Temperature checks will be taken upon entering the building.
- Children K-6 must be accompanied by an adult and stay with that adult at all times. Children will not be allowed to run around the facility.
- Masks are required!
- Fans are asked to sit on their assigned sides and in your family groups with 6 feet between each group. Home fans will be on the south side of the gym and visiting fans will be on the north side of the gym.
- Please practice social distancing as much as possible
- Concessions will be open for snacks and drinks. This will be open only during game times not before or in-between games.
- On days when there are three (3) or more games, the Junior High spectators may be required to leave the building to make room for the High School spectators.
- All spectators and participants will exit the building into the parking lot from the northwest and northeast sides of the gym.
- Anyone not adhering to the guidelines may be asked to leave the facility.

OUTDOOR CONTESTS

- Outdoor activities are limited to 500 total people in attendance.
- Contact Tracing. Each team is to provide a form with Student/Athlete guests. There will also be a sheet at the gate for extra spectators.
- We are asking that all spectators wear masks.
- Temperature checks will be taken upon entering the facility.
- All spectators will enter through the East entrance (off of Central) All other gates will be locked. If a spectator is requiring special parking due to a disability, arrangements will need to be made ahead of time by contacting the school and requesting special parking.
- Home team athletes will be limited to four (4) spectators per athlete on the roster. The team members will be given four (4) tickets to hand out prior to each home game. Visiting teams will be limited to two (2) spectators per athlete on the roster. Additional spectators will be allowed until our maximum occupancy is reached.
- Spectators and participants may leave the facility upon the conclusion of the varsity game through the main entrance or the back entrance by the shop.
- No one will be allowed to enter the building except the home and visiting teams and the officials.
- Children K-6 must be accompanied by an adult and stay with that adult at all times. Children will not be able to run around, play in the endzones, or other campus areas.
- Visiting fans will use the bleachers on the East side of the field
- Home fans will use the home bleachers on the West side of the field
- Porta-Potties will be set up on the visiting and home sides of the field.
- Please social distance as much as possible
- Anyone not adhering to the guidelines may be asked to leave.
