The XCELL! Program

I understand the XCELL! Program, is an afterschool and summer enrichment program that is federally funded and is offered free of charge to my child and to my family. I also understand that my child must follow the rules below.

Program Rules

- 1. Respecting others and self. Fighting will not be tolerated and write ups will be given.
- 2. Use positive language. Foul language or any other inappropriate language will not be tolerated.
- 3. Follow staff instruction for safety of all those in the program.
- 4. Remain in the designated activity area.
- 5. Students must remain with staff members until parents or authorized pick-up person arrives. Any other arrangement for getting students home must be made with the program director.
- 6. Students should take pride in themselves and their environment. The goal is to keep activity areas clean. Take care of facilities and materials. Students may be charged for damage to building and property.

Note: The program director may at anytime withdraw a student from the program for any of the following reasons.

- 1. Failure to meet appropriate behavior standards.
- 2. Refusal to follow program procedures and rules.
- 3. Verbal abuse, physical abuse, or sexual harassment of students or staff member by students or their parents.
- 4. Being at the wrong place at an unauthorized departure from a bus or activity site.
- 5. Consistent late pick-up (up to 3).
- 6. Failure to provide required records.
